WINTER BREAK!

Town and Country Preschool will close the Preschool and Pre-K classes from December 22 - January 2. We will resume classes on Monday, January 5, 2009. The extended care class will remain open with the exception of Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Preschool and Pre-k parents will not be billed for the break. However, if you are in the extended care class and you choose to take time off, you will still be required to pay regular tuition for your regularly scheduled days.

Snow Closure Policy

We have designed two separate snow closure policies due to the different needs of our families.

Our policies are as follows:

If District 49 closes due to inclement weather, we will close the two preschool classrooms. The extended care class will remain open UNLESS Town and Country Preschool determines the need to close. If a delay is announced by the district, Town and Country Preschool will run classes as scheduled unless otherwise determined.
